Frequently Asked Questions:

Does Grace Notes Violin Studio, LLC only have violinists available to play at weddings?

No. Grace Notes Violin Studio is owned by violinist Genny Denton. The studio has another violinist, a violist, and a cellist on staff as well. However, Grace Notes also contracts any other symphonic instrument including: harp, organ, flute, trumpet, piano etc. All musicians are experienced professionals holding at least a master's degree in music.

Additionally, Grace Notes can provide any combination of instruments desired. String quartets, duos, trios, and solos are the most common, but any other arrangement can be done.

Grace Notes Violin Studio also has a composer on staff who can arrange or write selections of music for your next event.

Will Grace Notes Violin Studio help me make good musical choices for my wedding?

Yes! When you choose Grace Notes to meet any or all of your musical needs, you will receive free consultations to customize and plan the music for your wedding. If you already know what selections you want, you may tell the musicians and they will prepare those pieces for you.

If you have no idea which selections you'd like, you may hear samples of music and decide or discuss typical choices with a representative. A Grace Notes representative will always make sure that you've made appropriate selections that represent your personal style and tastes.

Will I receive a contract?

Yes. Once you have decided to contract our services, a contract will be prepared by GNVS. This contract will be sent to you and will need to be returned with a deposit to secure your event date. The contract will specifically outline all of details of your big day, so that once it is returned, it will be one less thing you have to worry about in preparing your wedding!

What are your rates?

Rates vary depending upon the length and involvement during the rehearsal, ceremony, and/or reception. If multiple musicians are required, this changes the rates as well. If musicians are required to travel outside of Baton Rouge, small travel fees may also be assessed. Occasionally if Grace Notes has to purchase music selections to meet your special requests for music, small fees to cover the purchase may be added to your bill.

A quote will always be given to you and agreed upon before you are asked to sign a contract.

I'd like for Grace Notes to do some of my music, but not all of it. Is this okay?

Absolutely. Grace Notes musicians can perform as much or as little music in your wedding/reception as you like. Simply make the musicians aware of your needs. Complete, flat-rate wedding packages start as low as \$150. However, rates can vary depending upon how much or how little musicians are utilized during the rehearsal, ceremony, and/or reception.
